

**Commissioners of Mardela Springs
Town Meeting – November 21, 2017**

Attendance: Stanford Robinson, David Insley, Mike Murphy, Mary Bailey and Debra Bailey

The meeting is called to order with the pledge to the flag.

Debbie motions to dispense with the reading of the minutes, Mary seconds. Passed.

Tim Robinson reports that there is not much police activity besides speeding. Stanford communicates Mr. Osowiecki's question regarding putting a stop sign on Main Street to slow traffic down. Tim says that you cannot simply place a stop sign anywhere you desire. There has to be a need and an appropriate placement. He suggests other signage such as "speed limit is strictly enforced," etc.

Mr. Kilmer informs the Commissioners that Wicomico County is updating their animal ordinance and asks if they have any input. The updates that he mentions will be included cover everything the Commissioners have concerns about. He also lets them know that the County is attempting to speed up the process of repairing/replacing Barren Creek Road by using reserves rather than borrowing funds.

Mr. Benson has discovered that 214 Bridge Street was also purchased by Mr. Chase at Tax Sale and will be looking into possibly purchasing said property.

The proposal sent to the Federal government for grant money was approved, but not by the Community Legacy Grant. The grant program that accepted it approved up to \$80,000 towards sidewalk improvements.

Mike has received an estimate for the survey of the playground at \$2,000. He would like to get a couple more for comparison purposes before initiating a contract with anyone.

The replacement of the electric poles by Delmarva Power has been delayed and will hopefully be happening in the next couple weeks.

An Ordinance Work Session is not scheduled due to the upcoming holidays.

There being no further business, Debbie made a motion to adjourn, Mary seconded, passed.
