

Commissioners of Mardela Springs Town Meeting – July 17, 2018

Attendance: Stanford Robinson, Mary Bailey, Mike Murphy, Debbie Bailey, and Angie Drehmer

The meeting is called to order with the pledge to the flag.

Debbie motions to dispense with the reading of the minutes, Mary seconds. Passed.

Kortney makes Commissioners aware that the Tax Roll was not received from Wicomico County until July 12th. She will prepare tax bills as timely as possible.

There is no news in regards to the Community Development Block Grant.

Mike Murphy motions that the Commissioners approve and sign the revised grant application. Debbie seconds, passed.

Debbie reports that MuirTech is being sent a letter in regards to the starting timeframe of the boat ramp renovations around September 15th.

The Eyeful Hummingbird has been sent their MDE approved mitigation plan that they will follow through on as soon as weather permits.

Mr. VanMeter reports on his observations at the end of Fire Protection Road as requested. The trash can has been stolen and he believes that the bulkhead is compromised. He does not think that the placement of the bench is safe. The Commissioners request that he look into moving/removing the bench and placing safety signs around the bulkhead.

He also reports that 305 Bratten Street is currently operating as an unlicensed rental.

He brings up for discussion with the Commissioners and Mr. Benson what the protocols should be when dealing with a rental agency. Mr. Benson advises him to always cite the owner of the property, not the rental agency, as they are the ones who hired the agency.

Mr. Adams from the church provides the Commissioners with his research on the cheapest and best speed awareness sign he could find. Upon reviewing his research, and having Mr. VanMeter review, Mary motions to purchase the sign. Debbie seconds, passed. Debbie also states that she has talked to Tim Robinson about getting a deputy in town regularly.

Henry Osowiecki Jr. brings up the cedar trees at 205 Main Street. They are not on his property, but he has been trimming them. He requests permission to cut them down and it is granted. He also asks if he can put a small sign up for his wife's home craft business. Mr. VanMeter requests a drawing to determine if a sign permit is needed.

An Ordinance Work Session was not scheduled.

There being no further business, Debbie made a motion to adjourn, Mary seconded, passed.
