TOWN MEETING – APRIL 16, 2019

We are waiting for official notification of the grant for the replacement of the playground equipment at the ball park. Construction to be held in early August if possible.

Donald Robinson asked about a variance for the lot in the back of his house. Someone is interested in buying the lot and they are concerned about the set back. He will contact the prospective buyer about getting a sketch of how they want to layout the house.

103 James Street – request to build a deck on the back of the house. Because it is in the critical areas, Robert VanMeter needs to get specific calculations of the addition.

There are 2 swimming pools in the town that either need to be repaired or removed. Robert VanMeter will follow up. There are also a couple of untagged vehicles and he will address.
